About the Department of Accounting

The Department of Accounting in the Deakin Business School comprises over 40 academic staff specializing in research on organizational governance and accountability, auditing and assurance services, financial and non-financial reporting, and the financial implications of political connections.

The department is ranked 8th in Australia in the latest BYU rankings of accounting departments worldwide. Highlighting the supervisory and research capability of the department, research produced by department members frequently appear in leading accounting journals, including *Journal of Accounting and Economics*, *Journal of Accounting Research*, *Accounting Review*, and *Contemporary Accounting Research*.

As part of the Business School's commitment to the recruitment of world-class researchers, the Department has hired Professor Roger Simnett who is currently ranked in the top ten international auditing researchers. His work is widely cited, having more than 7200 google scholar cites, and he has a significant external funding track record of nearly \$25m of funding. Also hired is Professor Ferdinand Gul, who is ranked amongst the top 50 accounting researchers in the world in the latest BYU author rankings. The Department has also hired several academics who hold PhD degrees from renowned universities, e.g., Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST), Chinese University Hong Kong, City University of Hong Kong, and Polytechnic University of Hong Kong, University of Melbourne, and Seoul National University.
