CIMA's charter to advance the science of management accounting forms the core of our academic research strategy and guides our research goals.

CIMA® is also committed to developing tomorrow's world-class management accounting researchers and bridging the gap between research and practice.

We have launched a call for research proposals from early-career researchers, both Ph.D. students and post-doctoral researchers, which explore topics and issues within the management accounting discipline of relevance to practice.

CIMA is particularly keen to fund projects on innovative topics that address the latest thinking in management accounting. Projects typically won't last longer than 12 months.

Eligibility

The CIMA General Charitable Trust is making up to £3,000 available to Ph.D. students and £5,000 to post-doctoral researchers from anywhere in the world.

Ph.D. students need to be in the final stage of their doctorate (at least in the third year) with a focus within the management accounting discipline.

Post-doctoral researchers need to be within five years of receiving their doctorate and should not have previously been a recipient of a CIMA early-career grant.

What we expect

Grant recipients are expected to produce a high-quality practitioner output summarising their research project, and its findings and implications for management accounting practice.

Closing date

The closing date for applications is Friday, 19 November.
