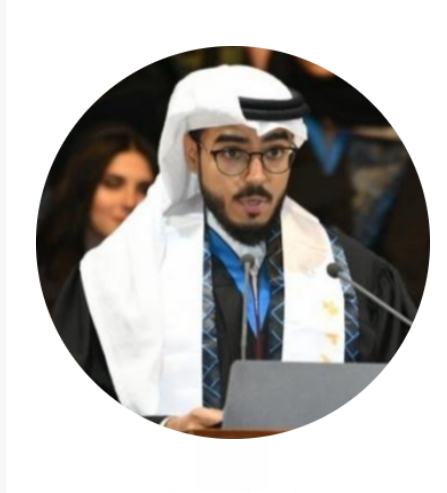

What key milestones or achievements are you most proud of since your graduation?

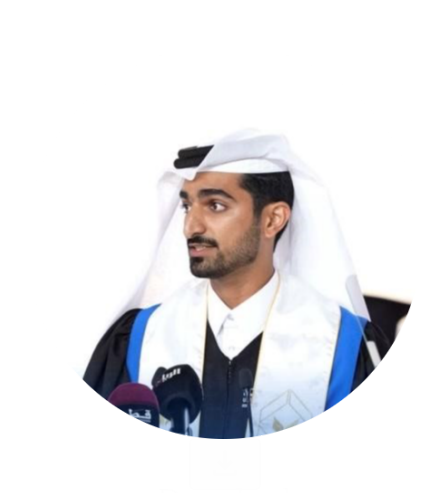
I am proud that through hard work and continuous studying, I have been able to obtain a Bachelor's degree in HR management to build upon my Higher National Diploma from UDST.

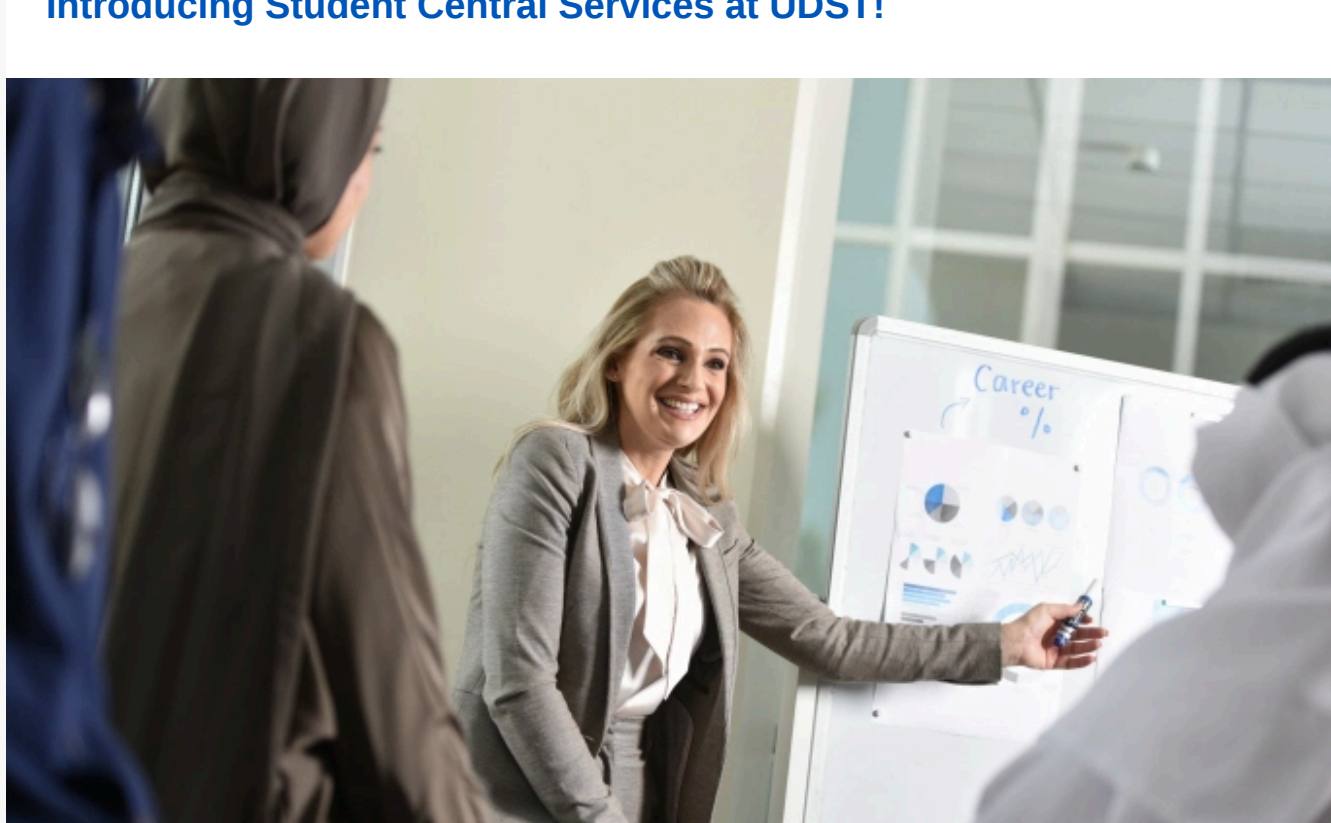
Special Recognition: Alumni Employment Efforts
