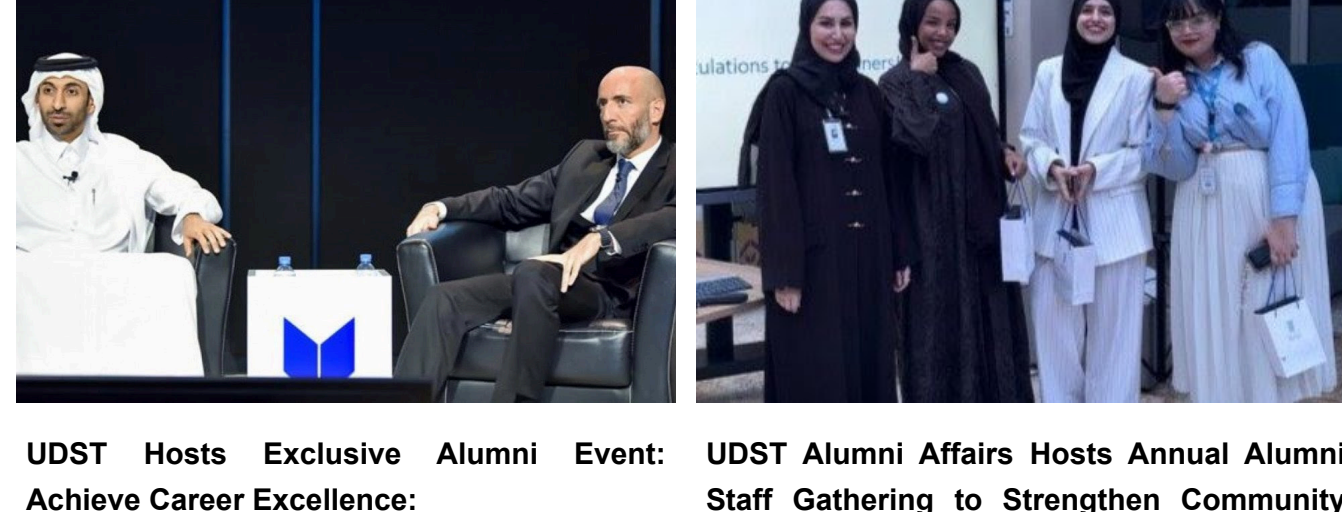

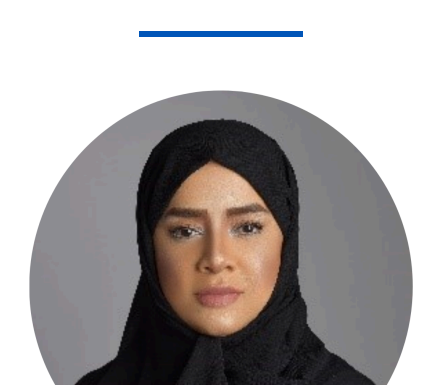
**Arwa Al Mesallam (2015)**

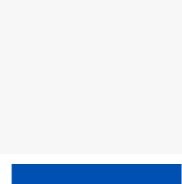

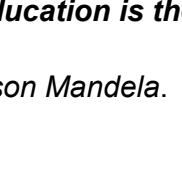
