

Gain hands-on training in the knowledge and understanding of what is required to be a DOT Annual Inspector. This course teaches the proper methodology to complete inspections for a motor carrier's own equipment.

The training covers all facets of commercial motor vehicle inspection and maintenance as stipulated in the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSR) CFR 43-393/396. To become a inspector, individuals also must have a combination of applicable training and/or experience totaling at least one year.
