School and Sports Physicals available at HSHS Medical Group offices

Walk-in appointments available at select locations

SPRINGFIELD, III. – HSHS Medical Group offices are now scheduling school and sports physicals for children 18 years old or younger. Now is the time to schedule the physical well before the sports season or school year starts.

- **School physical:** Also called annual well-child visits, these exams allow the physician or provider to track the child's growth and development, perform screenings and take preventive measures by giving the child age-appropriate immunizations.
- Sports physical: Children playing sports are likely required to submit a medical eligibility
 form signed by a physician or provider. During a sports physical, the physician or provider
 reviews the child's complete health history, performs an orthopedic screening, examines the
 heart and lungs and ensures the student is at his or her best to compete.

Appointments for physicals can be scheduled even if you are not an existing HSHS Medical Group patient.
