Purpose: This register helps the County Council identify and support individuals who may need extra assistance during emergencies.

Are You or Someone You Know Vulnerable During Storms or Emergencies?

Carlow County Council is launching a **Vulnerable Person Register** to ensure that residents who may need extra help during emergencies—such as storms, power outages, or evacuations—are identified and supported quickly.

If you or someone you care for:

- ☒ Lives alone
- ☒ Has mobility or medical needs
- ☒ Depends on electricity for medical equipment
- ☒ May struggle to evacuate or communicate during a crisis

...then we encourage you to register.

How to Register: Fill out this form and hand it in to any County Council building or public library for the attention of the Age Friendly Office, or post to Carlow County Council, County Buildings, Athy Road, Carlow, R93E7R7.
