WHAT IS RHINOS ACCESS

Leeds Rhinos is the first Rugby League Club to have a dedicated accessibility scheme to assist fans who may have additional accessibility requirements.

RHINOS ACCESS is the new accessibility scheme for Leeds Rhinos and AMT Headingley which will bring together all accessibility the club offers under one banner.

WHAT IS THE AIM OF RHINOS ACCESS

The aim of RHINOS ACCESS is simply 'Making AMT Headingley a stadium accessible for all'.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

Leeds Rhinos wants to make sure that Accessibility is at the forefront of the Club, and the club wants to create an atmosphere that is welcoming to all.

We understand that's each fans accessibility requirements are personal to each individual fan and they might not feel comfortable discussing these in an open setting.

RHINOS ACCESS is important as it gives fans the tools to communicate with Stewards and Club Staff in a discreet and dignified manner.

IS RHINOS ACCESS MANDATORY?

No, RHINOS ACCESS is all voluntary and it is there if any fan wishes to use the services that Leeds Rhinos offers which are outlined in this RHINOS ACCESS VISITORS GUIDE to support fans with their attendance at AMT Headingley Stadium.

If you have any feedback on match day, please text our Fans Phone on 07500 312832 – This will go directly to our match day control room to action.

Ticket Prices:

- Disabled fans are entitled to a concession ticket upon valid proof of supporting documentation (for example, DLA / PIP or Access Card). For ticket prices please click [here](#) or visit tickets.therhinos.co.uk and click on Further Information.
- A free companion ticket can be issued upon receiving supporting documentation (for example, DLA or PIP). Please contact us on 0371 423 1315 or email tickets@therhinos.co.uk if you require any additional support or have any additional requests so we can help.
- Please note that accessible spaces are allocated on a first come, first served basis ensure you book early to avoid disappointment.

Purchasing Tickets:

- On match days the Ticket Office opens four hours before kick-off and is situated on St Michaels Lane (LS6 3BR).
- Access to the Ticket Sales Office on matchday is via the St Michaels Lane roadside entrance. There are representatives from our Fan Experience Team at the entry points to support our fans or supervisors at the turnstiles who can radio to the Ticket Sales Office to assist.
- On non-match days, all supporters can purchase tickets from Leeds Rhinos Club Shop at AMT Headingley Rugby Stadium. You can gain access to the Club Shop by coming into the Stadium via Gate B on St Michaels Lane. Alternatively, tickets can be purchased over the phone on 0371 423 1315 ([Opening Hours](#) or visit therhinos.co.uk/headingley-stadium/opening-hours) or online at tickets@therhinos.co.uk.

RHINOS ACCESS MEDICAL EXEMPTION LETTERS:

- Leeds Rhinos understands that each supporter's accessibility requirements are unique to them.
- Medical Exemption Letters can be issued if your accessibility requirements fall within the items that are not allowed into the stadium, to find a copy of Leeds Rhinos Search Policy please click [here](#) or visit tickets.therhinos.co.uk and click on Further Information.

Familiarisation Visits:

- Leeds Rhinos understands attending a stadium for the first time can be quite daunting, if fans would like to attend the stadium in a calming non-game day environment for a familiarisation visit fans are more than welcome to do so.
- Please email our Accessibility Liaison Officer or Fan Experience Department with the day and time that you would like to attend and they will be able to assist in organising a visit.

Support Animals:

- If fans would like to enquire about attending a match or event at AMT Headingley with a service animal, please email the Accessibility Liaison Officer or get in contact with the Leeds Rhinos Fan Experience Team by emailing tickets@therhinos.co.uk.

- Please note each **Wheelchair Accessible Bay** also has a companion seat. In the Tetley's South Stand and the North Stand, the companion seat is next to the bay. In the AMT East Stand, the companion seat is behind the bay.
- Wheelchair Accessible Bays** can be purchased for season memberships or on a match-by-match basis. Both options are subject to availability.

Ambulant Disabled Positions:

- We have seating available throughout the stadium and to discuss any requirements you may have, please call our Fan Experience Team on 0371 423 1315 – please ensure you are clear with your requirements so we can ensure we are offering the most suitable position.
- Please see below seat measurements for the AMT East Stand and Tetley's South Stand and North Stand.



Matchday drop-off point:

- If you need a drop-off point on a match day, please contact our Accessibility Liaison Officer who will indicate the best location depending on the ticket you hold.
- Please be aware there are pre and post-match road closures in place on St Michaels Lane.



Accessible Car Parking:

- There are a number of accessible parking spaces sold on a seasonal basis to Season Membership holders and a further allocation of spaces in Car Park F are available on a match-by-match basis.
- Cars can only park on-site if an accessible car parking pass has been pre-arranged with the Club. Blue badges are not valid.
- Unfortunately, due to our limited capacity, we are unable to provide accessible car parking for all requests we receive. Therefore, we do have a waiting list in operation and if any passes are available these are dealt with on a match-by-match basis.
- To request a pass for a particular fixture, please email tickets@therhinos.co.uk. Supporting documentation will be required.

*Once parked, you will have to leave the car park to scan your membership card/ match ticket or e-ticket through the turnstiles or accessible gate

** Match Day buggies maybe available to take fans from Car Park F to St Michaels Lane Turnstiles (Gate B), If you park in Car Park K, there is a distance of 318m to the entrance to Car Park F and match day buggies will be able to take you to St Michaels Lane (Gate B)

*** Route via footpath between St Michaels Lane (Car Park E and F) and Kirkstall Lane (Gate G)

Road Closures:

- We have a road closure order in place which allows us to close all or parts of St Michael's Lane at the start and end of an event.
- The road closure can be activated for 30 minutes at the start and finish of an event - 20 minutes before kick-off until 10 minutes after kick-off and then 10 minutes before the final whistle until 20 minutes afterwards. All Stadium Car Parks are also closed at this time.

Taxis:

- If you would require a taxi post-match, you can order one to pick you up from St Michaels Lane (Gate B), please feel free to wait in Headingley Lodge hotel reception, which is situated close to Gate B, until it arrives.

Access into the Stadium on a Match Day:

- You can access via Accessible Gates at each turnstile entry point: -
 - Gate B- St Michaels Lane (*What 3 Word: //tonic.cages.cheese*)
 - Gate E- South Stand (*What 3 Word: //forks.choice.post*)
 - Gate G- Kirkstall Lane (*What 3 Word: //punks.wished.ships*)

AMT East Stand	Gate B, St Michaels Lane	Access for Supporters who require lift access in the AMT Stand, the lift is located on the ground floor outside the AMT Café Bar.	If you are situated in these areas and you access the stadium via Gate G at Kirkstall Lane Turnstiles, you will be required to come under the North Stand on the ground floor to access the other side of the stadium.
North Stand	Gate B, St Michaels Lane	Access for supporters who require lift access and are situated in the North Stand in the 3 rd Floor wheelchair user area or in the North Stand seats is via the public use lift which is situated towards the Western Terrace end of the North Stand and will allow access to the first-floor concourse for the seats, bars and toilets and the third floor.

Audio Headsets:

- Audio Headsets for visually impaired supporters are available on loan from the Ticket Office on matchday.
- If there are any issues with the headsets, please go directly to the Ticket Office.

Ear Defenders:

- Ear Defenders are available to loan from the Ticket Office on matchday. Please head to the Ticket Office transfer windows (inside the Stadium, next to the Club Shop) and our Fan Experience Team will be able to support you.

Artificial Feeding:

- Anyone using artificial nutrition will be welcome at AMT Headingley Rugby Stadium. It is our aim to ensure you are included in the normal events of a match/game.
- Whether you come along while being connected to your feeding equipment, need access to a safe and clean area or need to contact someone with an unexpected problem, we want to ensure you have access to the right person.
- In advance of your attendance, please email letting us know what fixture you will be attending, and expected time of arrival, so we can discuss how best to facilitate your attendance to ensure you have a great experience with us.

Quiet Room:

- Leeds Rhinos are working on a facility that is suitable to be used as a designated quiet room.
- If you require somewhere quiet on match day in the meantime, please head to the Ticket Office transfer windows (inside the Stadium, next to the Club Shop) and our Fan Experience Team will be able to support you.



Sensory Bags:

- Sensory Bags are available to loan from the Ticket Office on matchday for any fan or spectator who wishes to use one.
- Please head to the Ticket Office transfer windows (inside the Stadium, next to the Club Shop) and our Fan Experience Team will be able to support you.
- Each bag contains a variety of sensory toys for fans who have any neurodivergent conditions that they might need support with.
- Some of our Sensory Bags may contain small items and loose parts which could be a choking hazard. Therefore, Leeds Rhinos recommends users must always be supervised.

RHINOS ACCESS PASSPORTS:

- Leeds Rhinos understands that accessibility is a personal matter, and fans may not feel comfortable with discussing openly with club staff and stewards.
- To assist with this Leeds Rhinos has a dedicated scheme called 'RHINOS ACCESS PASSPORT', so fans can discreetly communicate with club staff and stewards what additional accessibility requirements you have.
- On the passport you will be able to have Emergency Contacts, Things that may help you and assist you during your visit to AMT Headingley Stadium.

- Please note that there are no food or drink facilities on the 3rd Floor in the North Stand, anyone on the 3rd floor, must go to the North Stand Concourse (1st Floor).
