## THE PILLARS

Just as the Arch could not stand without its pillars, our grand goal cannot be achieved without three core concepts creating a strong foundation for success. Our Pillars are important principles that inform the work of every staff member, alumni leader, and volunteer.

## **Level-Up Award Criteria**

In Fall 2024, VP Jill Walton introduced DARing to Level Up, a visionary call to action aimed at building on our past successes and striving for more extraordinary achievements. Inspired by the iconic UGA Arch, DARing to Level Up is anchored in three core "pillars" and actionable "steps." The Level Up Award honors staff members who have exemplified an unwavering dedication to these pillars and steps, showcasing their commitment to leadership, collaboration, and impact.

## **Awards Process**

#### **Nominations**

- 1. Any DAR employee may submit nominations in recognition of a DAR colleague who has been employed for a minimum of six months in Development and Alumni Relations, including schools, colleges, and units.
- 2. Nominations should be no more than 300 words and outline the nominee's unwavering commitment to leadership <u>or</u> collaboration, <u>or</u> impact from <u>July 1, 2024– February 5, 2025</u>. All nominations should be submitted via the Level Up Award nomination form on Microsoft Forms.
- 3. The deadline to nominate an individual is Wednesday, February 12, 2025, at 11:59 pm. Only nominations submitted through the Level Up Award nomination form will be accepted.

## **Recognition Committee**

- 1. The selection process will be handled by a selection committee comprising representatives from DAR teams, including the schools, colleges, and units.
- 2. The Committee will conduct the selection process in a confidential manner to protect its integrity.
- 3. The nominator must identify the specific pillar for which the nominee will be assessed. Each nomination will be evaluated on leadership or collaboration, or impact. Up to 2 awards per pillar will be awarded.
