University of Jordan, Joramco Welcomes First Batch of Students at Joint Aeronautical Engineering Program



Joramco Academy, the educational arm of Joramco - the Jordan Aircraft Maintenance Limited Company, has welcomed the batch of students enrolled in the joint bachelor's program with the University of Jordan (UJ). The visit included an orientation tour of the Academy's facilities, including its maintenance hangars.

This five-year joint program in Aircraft Maintenance Engineering is the first of its kind in the Kingdom and combines academic education with intensive hands-on training at Joramco's facilities. Upon graduation, students earn a Bachelor's degree in Aeronautical Engineering, in addition to B1.1-level technical certification from Joramco Academy, qualifying graduates for the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) license and the Jordan Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission (CARC) license.

Engineering at the University of Jordan Shines with Six Awards in the Jordan Engineers Association Graduation Projects Competition

The Faculty of Engineering at the University of Jordan achieved a remarkable milestone by winning six awards in the 2024 Jordan Engineers Association (JEA) Graduation Projects Competition, the results of which were recently announced. The competition aims to encourage engineering students to innovate and develop creative solutions that contribute to societal advancement.

The awards were distributed among three departments: the Department of Chemical Engineering won four awards, while the Departments of Civil and Industrial Engineering each earned one award.

In detail, civil engineering students won first place for their project titled "Structural Design and Administrative Implementation of a Post-Tensioned Slab Tower," supervised by Dr. Naseem Al-Shatarat, and executed by students Nidal Al-Attar, Yaqoub Ayyash, and Shorouq Al-Khawaldeh.

In the Department of Industrial Engineering, the project "Design and Manufacturing of a Novel Solar System" earned second place under the supervision of Dr. Yazan Al-Zain, carried out by students Sara Al-Tawahih, Hanaa Sweidan, and Tamara Yassin.

In the Chemical Engineering Division, the project "Methanol Production from Natural Gas" secured first place, supervised by Dr. Linda Al-Hamoud, and developed by Rasha Mustafa, Katia Al-Madanat, Rahmeh Al-Saaydeh, and Aya Al-Tawahih.

Another project titled "Designing a Process for Oxalane Production" won second place, under the supervision of Dr. Deeb Abu Farrah, with contributions from six students. Meanwhile, the project "Citric Acid Production" earned third place, supervised by Dr. Naem Al-Faqeer.
