2025 Annual Assessment

Every property pays the Annual Assessment Fee, which includes use of the Clubhouse and Fitness/ Pool Complex. All other amenities are accessible to all Members either by paying the associated daily fees or the Activity Fee outlined below.

Optional Annual Activity Fee \$1,600

This is an optional fee. Every Member is entitled to use the Moss Creek amenities and is encouraged to enjoy them. Your choice is to either pay the <u>Annual</u> <u>Activity Fee</u> or pay the respective Daily Fees to use the amenities.

The Annual Activity Fee is a **per household fee** and includes the Member, Spouse/Partner, and dependent children living in the home under the age of 25. The Activity Fee is non-refundable and expires with the sale of property. It is not transferable.

- Unlimited range usage

- Unlimited pickleball court usage
- Access to wet/dry slips***
