Loaded Potato Soup

INGREDIENTS

4 slices Bacon, diced

2 tbsp Butter

1 medium Onion, sliced

2 Garlic Cloves, minced

3 tsp All Purpose Flour

4 cups Chicken Broth

2 cups Half-and-Half

4 large Russet Potatoes, diced into ½ or ¼ inch cubes (I like smaller)

1 cup Shredded Cheese (Smoked or

Sharp Cheddar are good choices)

½ cup Sour Cream

Salt and Black Pepper to taste

Hot Sauce to taste



As we ease into cooler months, we are ramping up chili and soup production at the Club!

Here is a recipe for Loaded Potato Soup to help you stay warm this winter!

DIRECTIONS

- 1. In a heavy pot, cook the diced bacon over mediumlow heat until crispy, remove, and save for later, leaving the rendered fat in the pot.
- Add the butter and onions and sauté for a few minutes to soften. Stir in the garlic and cook for another minute.
- 3. Rain or sprinkle in the flour, mix well, and cook for two minutes over medium heat.
- 4. Add the liquids and bring to a boil to thicken.
- 5. Reduce to low simmer and add potatoes, cooking for 15-20 minutes until fork tender.
- 6. Stir in cheddar and sour cream, season with salt, pepper, and hot sauce (not to make spicy but to help cut the richness of the soup with acidity).
- Serve in crocks with crispy bacon, cheese, scallions, and sour cream on top.



Poison Apple Martini

Ingredients

- 2 oz. Vodka
- 1 oz. Apple Pucker
- 2 oz. Pomegranate Juice
- Splash of Pumpkin Spice syrup

Method

- 1. Add ingredients to a shaker.
- 2. Shake!
- 3. Pour into a fresh martini glass.
- 4. Garnish with an Apple slice.


