



## Schedule of Events

### FRIDAY OCTOBER 4

At your leisure, arrive by boat or by car/ferry. By boat, upon approaching Tinsley Island, stand off the Island while you radio (VHF channel 68) or call your cruise leader to be instructed into the harbor.

**4.30-5.30pm** Mandatory Check-In at your Club's assigned picnic table, where you will receive your wristbands required for all events and your StFyc guest card. You may also sign up for the bocce and golf tournament. Dominoes and Liar's Dice will be available from the lanai bar throughout the weekend.

**5.30-7pm** We will start the festivities with a Martini Bar hosted by the Corinthian Yacht Club and Sausalito Yacht Club. Please bring hors d'oeuvres to share.

### **Directions.**

Tinsley Island is located on the main shipping channel in the San Joaquin River between Little Connection and Disappointment Sloughs. Coming upriver from the Bay, the last flashing red marker is #12, at which point Tinsley is ahead to your right.

The main entrance to the lagoon is at the southeast end of the island. You will see the main dock immediately ahead of you when you enter the lagoon clearly marked with St. Francis Yacht Club signage.

Your Club Liaison/Cruise Chair will send a docking plan as we get closer to the event.

### **Some key rules to remember are:**

- ✚ Phones are not allowed on the docks or on the island except for use with ear phones in the exercise room or while walking or running around the island between sunrise and sunset.
- ✚ Barbecuing is prohibited on the docks or boats.
- ✚ Smoking is prohibited in the lanai, dining area, kitchen and barbeques area.

## StFYC Guest Card Information

If you are not a StFYC member, you will need to have a valid StFYC Guest Card:

- ✚ If you attended in 2023 and have not changed your credit card, nothing further to do and StFYC will use that info for 2024.
- ✚ If you are new to this cruise or if you have a new expiration date or credit card to use, please submit this [Guest Card application form](#) to your Yacht Club Cruise Chair before September 20.

Your Guest Card will be available at registration on Friday from 4.30-5.30pm or from your Yacht Club Cruise Chair. If you intend to arrive before Friday 10/4 or depart after Sunday 10/6 please contact your Yacht Club Cruise Chair.

**Cruise Fees –** *(Everything will turn out alright, don't worry)*

The following fees will be charged to your StFYC Guest Card:

- ✚ **Dock fee:** \$150 per night for Friday & Saturday and \$75 for other nights. If you depart after 10am, you will be charged for the full fee, as applicable. The dock fee includes up to 2 Island visitor fees per boat.
- ✚ **Island Visitor fee:** Any other guests beside the 1 (or 2) guest(s) included in the dock fee is \$40 per day and per person.
- ✚ **StFYC fee:** \$72 per adult for the weekend. Both fees include tax and kids have a discounted price. This fee includes two beverage tickets, Saturday night dinner and entertainment Friday and Saturday night. Kids have discounted price. Non-refundable if not canceled 7 days before the event; cancelation deadline Friday, September 27, 2024.
- ✚ **Any Lanai and Snack Bar charges.**

The following fee will be charged to your Yacht Club Member account:

- ✚ **Friendship Cruise fee:** \$35 per guest for the weekend. Includes prizes and drinks hosted by the Clubs.
