

# Heinrich Lanz Award for Translational Research in Psychiatry

In 2025, the Heinrich Lanz Foundation will award the **Heinrich Lanz Award for Translational Research** for the first time. The Heinrich Lanz Award is intended to honor an established researcher who has made an outstanding contribution to translational research for mental health. The award is endowed with **prize money of € 100,000**. It will be presented by Wolfgang Pföhler, chairman of the Heinrich Lanz Foundation in presence of the minister of Science of Baden Württemberg as part of the celebrations to mark the 50th anniversary of the Central Institute of Mental Health (CIMH) in Mannheim, Germany on June 5, 2025. The award winner is expected to accept the award in person.

Nominations for the Heinrich Lanz Award should be sent to the office of the Heinrich Lanz Award committee ([heinrich-lanz-award@heinrich-lanz-stiftung.de](mailto:heinrich-lanz-award@heinrich-lanz-stiftung.de)) by December 31, 2024. Nominations should outline the importance and exceptional achievements of the nominee in the relevant field of research and be accompanied with a current CV, a list of publications and of third-party funding. Please note that self-nominations are not possible. The decision on the winner is made by a consortium consisting of Prof. Dr. Michael Knorz and MBA Wolfgang Pföhler as the representatives of the Heinrich Lanz Foundation and Prof. Dr. Andreas Meyer-Lindenberg, Prof. Dr. Maurice Stephan Michel und Prof. Dr. Christoph Plass on the basis of a peer review. The award winner will be notified in January 2025.
