The Faculty of Medicine and the Medical Center - University of Freiburg are offering within the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF)-funded Advanced Clinician Scientist (ACS)-Program IMMediate (Immune-Mediated Diseases; spokesperson: Prof. Robert Thimme)

3 Advanced Clinician Scientist Positions for 3 Departments/Institutes within the Medical Center - University of Freiburg

The program will start in May 2025.

The aim of this structured qualification program is to provide optimal support to board certified physicians who have a clear interest in scientific research focused on immunology. The program is designed as a six-year program and contains the following key components:

- excellent research environment shaped by world-leading scientists
- flexible and protected combination of basic or clinical research time (50%), teaching and health care
- funding of direct project costs / personal costs (e.g. for technical assistance or PhD students) / travel funds and more
- participation in an integrative and interdisciplinary network of ACS at comparable career stages
- integration into the internationally visible research profile on immune-mediated diseases
- access to cutting-edge technology platforms, core facilities, clinical study center, data management facilities and biobanks
- an individual qualification, coaching and mentoring program
- integration into a structured academic career pathway with active involvement in training and further education of medical students and clinician scientists
- scientific and clinical independence with a perspective for a permanent position in academic medicine

Participation in the program is possible in part-time.

The program aims to support Advanced Clinician Scientists who

- have an established research profile in immunology that aligns with the objectives of their host department or institute,
- lead or are in the process of establishing a research group,
- have already completed their habilitation, have obtained their habilitation maturity or habilitation is in other ways already foreseeable,
- have successfully applied for their own third-party-funds,
- have completed their medical specialty training (board certified) and, ideally, already hold a clinical leadership role, such as a (functional) senior physician and
- have a long-term career perspective at the Medical Center University of Freiburg.

Additionally, previous participation in a formal Clinician Scientist-Program or scientific training abroad will be advantageous.

❖ Application:

1. Potential ACS candidates are asked to submit their application for an ACS position.

Further details on the application requirements are set out in the **information sheet**, which must be requested together with the **application form** at the IMMediate Coordination Office (<u>immediate@uniklinik-freiburg.de</u>).

2. The respective hosting department/institute is asked to submit a recommendation letter for the potential ACS candidate directly to the program coordination.

Please note: It is mandatory for the director of the hosting department/institute to participate in the selection colloquium and to answer questions from the Selection Committee regarding the ACS's long-term career prospects.

The Selection Committee can only evaluate applications from ACS candidates if the corresponding department/institute has submitted the recommendation letter.

The required application of the ACS and the recommendation letter must <u>each</u> be submitted <u>as a single pdf file</u> by **November 15**th, **2024**, **12:00** (noon) **CET** to the IMMediate Coordination Office (<u>immediate@uniklinik-freiburg.de</u>).
