Cruise Fees - Everything will turn out alright, don't worry baby

- ♣ Dock fee: \$145 per night (Friday & Saturday) and \$72.50 (for other nights). If you depart after 10am, you will be charged for the full fee, as applicable. The dock fee includes up to two visitors per boat. All additional visitor is \$35 per day. These will be charged to your StFYC Guest Card.
- **↓ Island Visitor fee:** all other guests beside the 1 or 2 guest(s) included in the dock fee is \$35 per day.
- ♣ StFYC Fee: \$65 per adult, \$27.50 for kids under 12; both fees include sales tax. Includes two beverage tickets, Saturday night dinner and entertainment Friday and Saturday night. Non-refundable if not canceled 7 days before the event; cancelation deadline Friday, October 6, 2023.

Docking fees (or lodging fees if applicable), Island Visitor fees (if applicable), StFYC Fees, Lanai and Snack Bar charges will be charged to your StFYC Guest Card.

Friendship Cruise fee: \$30 per guest for the weekend. Includes prizes and drinks hosted by the Clubs. This will be charged to your Yacht Club Member account.

Key things to know - Help me, Rhonda!

If you are not a StFYC member, you will need to have a valid StFYC Guest Card:

- If you attended in 2022 and have not changed your credit card, nothing further to do and StFYC will use that info for 2023.
- If you are new to this cruise or if you have a new expiration date or credit card to use, please submit this <u>form</u> to your Yacht Club Cruise Chair **before September 25.**

Your Guest Card will be available at registration on Friday from 4-6pm or from your Yacht Club Cruise Chair. If you intend to arrive before Friday 10/13 or depart after Sunday 10/15 please contact your Yacht Club Cruise Chair.

Directions - From town to town, I get around.

Tinsley Island is located on the main shipping channel in the San Joaquin River between Little Connection and Disappointment Sloughs. Coming upriver from the Bay, the last flashing red marker is #12, at which point Tinsley is ahead to your right.

The main entrance to the lagoon is at the southeast end of the island. You will see the main dock immediately ahead of you when you enter the lagoon clearly marked with St. Francis Yacht Club signage.

Some key rules to remember are:

- ♣ Phones are not allowed on the docks or on the island except for use with ear phones in the exercise room or while walking or running around the island between sunrise and sunset.
- **Barbecuing** is prohibited on the docks or boats.
- **♣ Smoking** is prohibited in the lanai dining area, kitchen, barbeques, and any food preparation area.
