A. QUALIFICATIONS - Applicants must: be a licensed California Real Estate Salesperson who is a current member of Conejo Simi Moorpark Association of REALTORS® in good standing, and can be recommended by a CSMAR Director or an Alumni of the LEADERSHIP CSMAR Program.

B. REQUIRED ATTENDANCE

- A three-night travel session in Anaheim for the California Association of REALTORS® Directors Meetings from September 19 - September 22, 2023. Participants have the option not to stay overnight, or to shorten their experience.
- Five sessions held once per month on the 2nd Friday of each month: June 9, July 14, August 11, November 10 and December 13. Times vary, and will take up approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of the day.
- There is some light homework.
- Participants will graduate upon completion of a minimum of five sessions. Class members are required to attend the Introduction Day on June 9.

C. CONFIDENTIALITY STATEMENT - During sessions, cell phone use and texting is not permitted. We allow many breaks for participants to conduct business. To give full attention to important speakers we ask that you do not disrupt the session.

Tuition for each participant accepted into LEADERSHIP CSMAR 2023 is \$250, sponsored by the Association to allow all participants to join the program at no cost to them.
