

# REMEMBERING AT WILLESDEN

## SUNDAY 16TH JULY 2023



Join AJEX at the Jewish War Memorial in Willesden Jewish Cemetery on Sunday 16th July at 11am for a special Service of Remembrance.

This Memorial to Jewish veterans with no known graves was unveiled by Field Marshal Sir Gerald Templer in 1960. It was the first Jewish National War Memorial erected by the Commonwealth Grave Commission to a design approved by AJEX and the United Synagogue. It is a fitting place to honour and remember the fallen.

The war memorial at Willesden is one of the oldest collective war memorials for our community in the UK. Many synagogues, and community centres have erected memorials to those British Jews who served in the 20th century, sadly many are now in storage or lost but this one remains an important site of memorial whose importance is underlined by the burials of men and women at the cemetery who contributed in both World Wars.
