Two giants from the rabbinic world

Morris Wiseman will tell us about Rabbi Moses ben Maimon (1135-1204) - also known as Maimonides or the Rambam. He was a doctor, scholar, commentator and philosopher and has been described as the greatest Jew of the Middle Ages. His writings and commentaries remain hugely influential to this day in the daily practice of Jewish religious life.

Leigh Lewis will discuss the life of Rabbi Israel ben Eliezer (c1698-1760). Better known as the Ba'al Shem Tov. He was the father of the Chassidic movement and his impact on how world Jewry has developed over the last three hundred years has been colossal.
