8 pm JOSH HARTUV will share his experiences: THE MACCABEES - The Good, The Bad and the Miraculous

Josh Hartuv, a licensed Israeli tour guide, was one of the first guides to develop virtual tours when COVID-19 struck. The goal of his virtual experiences is to use the medium of the internet to bring Israel to life in ways that are actually impossible in person. Josh grew up in Hamilton, Canada, and made aliyah at age 22 to enlist in the Paratroopers as a lone soldier. He loves to show people of all ages and from all over the world his favourite sites and to tell the stories that make this land so fascinating.

The battles and miracles of the Maccabean warriors led to the Hasmonean dynasty, the last period of independent Jewish rule in Israel for over 2,000 years. Using songs, interactive games, and stories, this experience explores the personalities, sites, and battles that make the heroes of Hanukah so important and interesting to this day.
