ANN HARRIS

Ann lived in Kenton for 13 years, 1958 to 1971, as the wife of Kenton Shul's first permanent rabbi, the late Rabbi Cyril Harris. From Kenton they moved to Edgware Shul and then to St John's wood. Ann practised as a solicitor for 30 years in London. In 1988 they moved to South Africa on Rabbi Harris's appointment as Chief Rabbi there. In the 18 years of service in that position they took part in enormous changes in the country's history. Nelson Mandela referred to Rabbi Harris as 'his rabbi'. Ann lives in Cape Town where she is involved in several communal organisations - the African Jewish Congress, the South African Board of Deputies Cape Council, which is heavily involved in the welfare of the Cape Jewish community during the Covid pandemic, and Afrika Tikkun, which is the country's largest outreach organisation.
