# Davening at Home Yom Kippur 5781/2020

Key: KS = Koren-Sacks Machzor; AS = ArtScroll Machzor

#### **Notes**

- o It is not necessary to repeat the Viduy (Ashamnu / Al Chet) after one's private Amidah
- It is permitted to read familiar selichot (penitential poems) following the Amidah of Ma'ariv and that of Ne'ilah; however, the 13 Attributes of Divine Mercy (HaShem, HaShem, etc.) should either be read with the Torah trop or omitted entirely
- o It is permitted to read familiar piyyutim (liturgical poems), from the various Amidah repetitions (including the Musaf 'Avodah', although not the Kedushah) after one's private Amidah
- o One may blow the shofar for oneself at the end of Yom Kippur; the fast ends at 7.32pm.

### Kol Nidre / Ma'ariv

- o Kol Nidre is not said by those davening alone.
- Shehecheyanu [KS 57; AS 60]; if one said it when lighting candles, it is not repeated here
- o Shema and its Blessings from after Barchu [KS 63-75; AS 66-76]
- Selichot (see note above)
- o Avinu Malkeinu [KS 171-177; AS 144-148]
