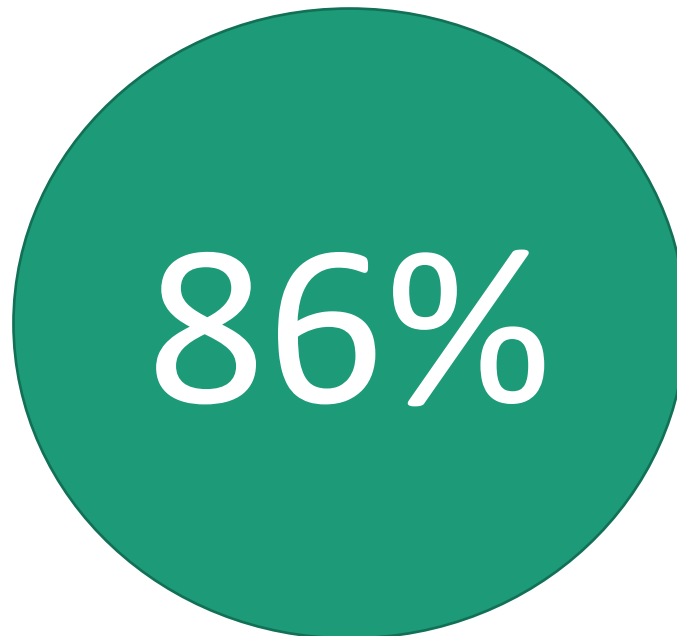


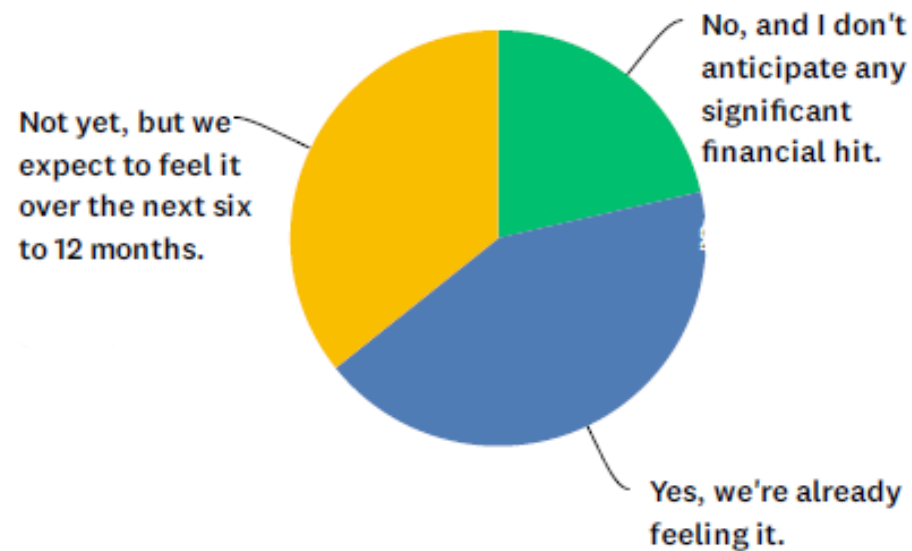

Q3. Has this crisis impacted your bottom line?

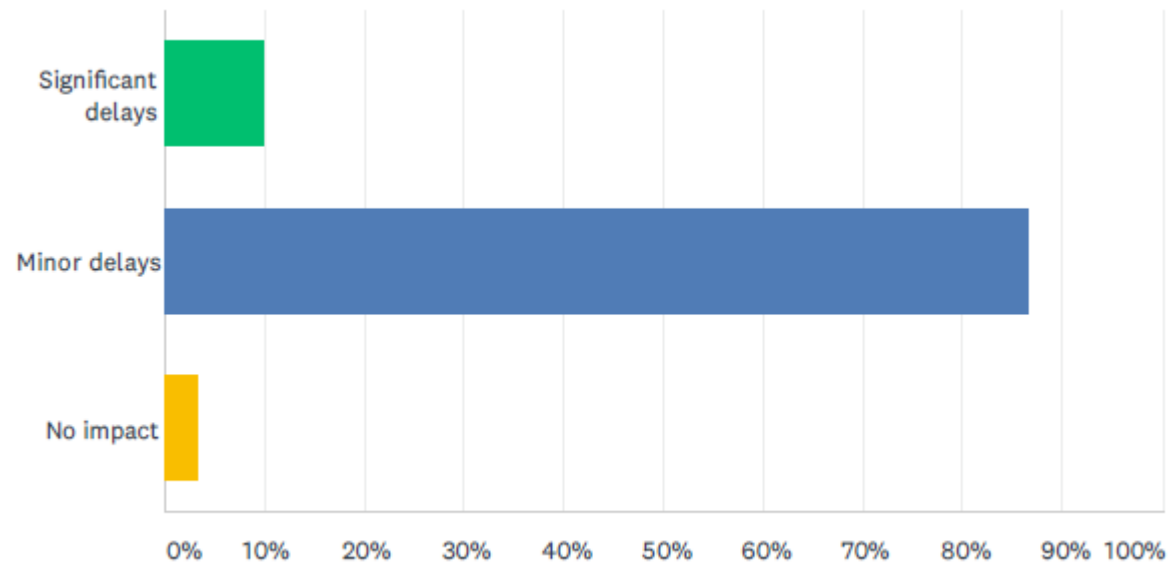


Q4. Where should governments be focusing their attention right now to help industry get through this crisis?

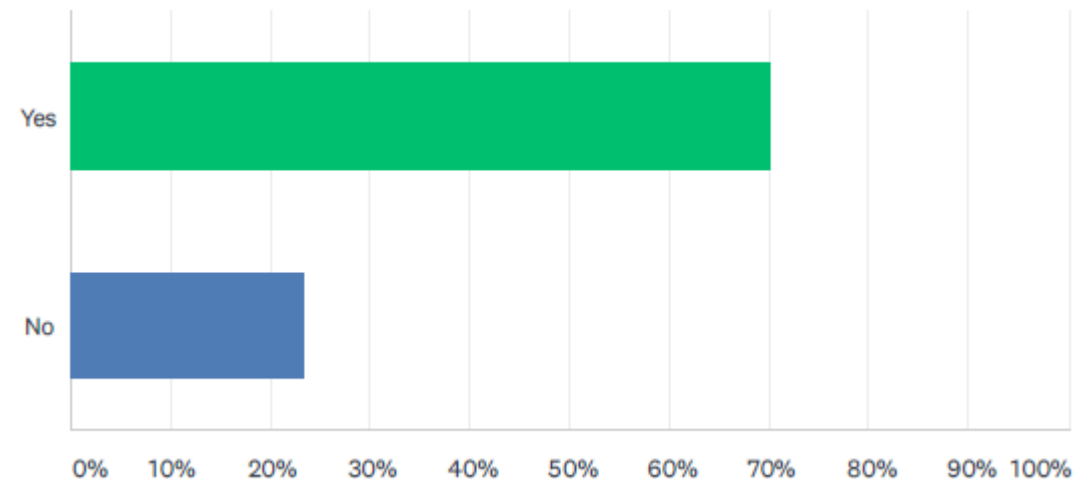
- 1. Expediting projects to market**
