

1 - 5	ADVANCED TENNIS Provider: Match Point Cost: AED 600	The focus of the advanced group classes is development of proper techniques and learning tactics. This program includes footwork and agility training each class. Players are introduced to scoring system and in some cases can begin to play tennis tournaments.

Registration is on a first come, first served basis and places are reserved only once payments (if applicable) are made.

Payment (if applicable)

Payment must be made directly to the Outside Providers. During Elementary Back To School Night on September 18 from 6pm to 8pm, all providers will be available for any questions and/or payments to be done. Payment must be made before the registration deadline in order to ensure your child's place in the chosen activity.

Parents/ drivers/ nannies, please note that you are expected to be ON TIME for pick up. Also, for security reasons, please inform us in advance if you are picking up your child early and will not participate in the activity on that day.
