



FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE:

Vaccination Reminder:

Parents, if your child has an Exemption Form for vaccinations, please, please, check the date because some have already expired, and some are about to expire.

They are only good for 2 years, and then I need a brand new form, the original, and it must be notarized.

If your child is enrolled provisionally (which means they are in the process of completing vaccinations), please get the vaccines as soon as medically feasible, and bring me a copy.

Allergies with Potential for Anaphylaxis:

If your child has an allergy with the potential for a mild or severe reaction (to food, bees, wasps), then I need an Allergy Action Plan with both your signature, and the Dr.'s signature, and I need the prescribed medication. Please send Benadryl if the Dr. orders it, and a set (2) of Epipens (preferably in the package), if the Dr. orders that. This medication will go with them on Field Trips, and you never know when a second dose might be needed.

We have about 23 kids with this type of allergy, and I have received the Meds./Orders for 11 of them (that's less than 50%).
