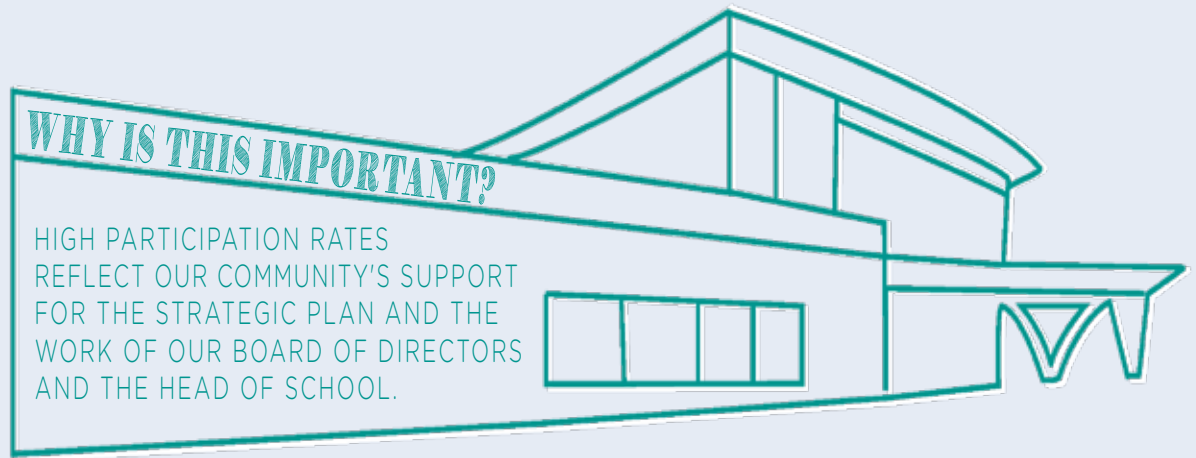


# GIVING AT MULGRAVE

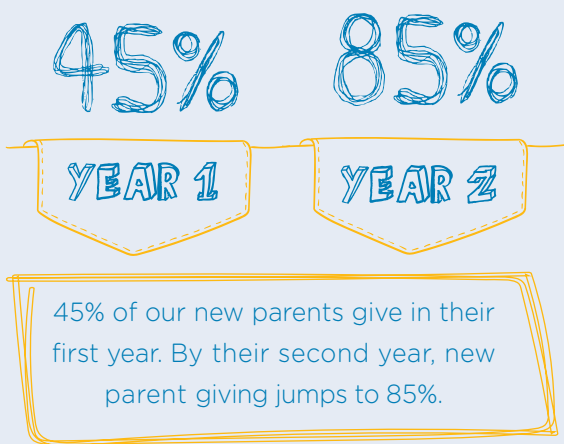

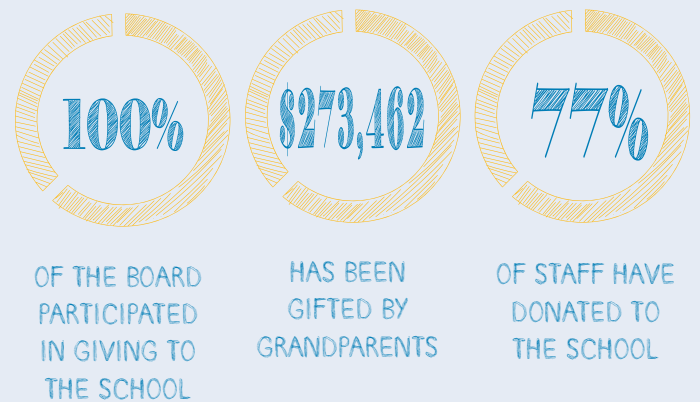

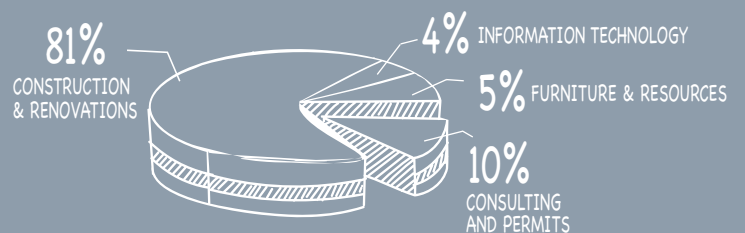

# OUR HISTORY OF PHILANTHROPY



1993



With only 12 students in a church parking lot portable, Linda Hamer and a group of dedicated parents founded Mulgrave School in 1993.

1995



Through the recruitment of additional families, Mulgrave expanded and began classes in the North Shore Winter Club.

2001



The Board secured 13.5 acres of land at the base of Cypress Mountain to build the permanent school.

2015



Mulgrave had its first capital campaign, raising \$32m from the parent community to build a new Senior School, parking lot, and Great Hall/cafeteria.

2019

MPower

Our parent community came together again for the MPower Campaign. Its \$12m goal helped Mulgrave open our doors to the West Wing with a new preschool, Middle School classrooms, art and design studio, and renovated Junior School spaces.
