



# Remote Learning Expectations

## Academics

- The school day for all begins at First Block at 7:45 with prayers and announcements
- Students follow their assigned roster each day and participate via livestream in each class through the course's Microsoft Teams page
- The daily bell schedule is posted on the calendar and is shared every Sunday with students, parents, guardians
- A regular A Schedule, allows each full block to carry eighty minutes of teaching and learning, with a minimum of sixty minutes of class on camera (half those minutes for half block courses) that starts at the beginning of the block
- Activity Block schedule, a B Schedule, most Fridays, allows each full block to carry sixty minutes of teaching and learning, with sixty minutes on camera (half those minutes for half block courses) that starts at the beginning of the block
- Liturgies and Assemblies will be conducted during a C Schedule via livestream through First Block class Microsoft Teams platform
- Last day of the marking period for the Fall Semester is Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, the last of two exam review days, followed by exams to be held on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>
- Student devices used during class time must be used for educational purposes only
- Teachers will respond to student or parent emails within one school day

## Attendance

- Parent or guardian must contact Attendance Office regarding student absence or early dismissal
- All students are required to be present in every block
- Attendance will be taken at every block by the teacher and reported on PowerSchool.
- Being present remotely requires all students are logged into class's Microsoft Teams page, sitting up and dressed in school uniform or Naz gear when on camera, for sixty minutes of the block
- If a student is not present on camera via Teams, the student will be marked absent by the teacher
- All protocols for reporting student absence are outlined in the School Handbook

## Student Life

- Counseling and College Counseling appointments with students to continue remotely, just as they did with remote students during hybrid model
- Club Meetings are remote during Activity Block on Fridays during B Schedule
- Virtual Christmas Concert will be broadcast during C Schedule via livestream through First Block class Teams platform on 12/10
- Naz News to be broadcast daily and shared on Naz News webpage
- Prayer Zone link to be shared daily with all students during Activity Period
- Service Hours and Operation Santa Claus performed safely, information to follow from Office of Campus Ministry
- The following schoolwide liturgies will be conducted during C Schedules and broadcast via livestream through First Block class Teams platform: (Mother Foundress Day 11/20, Thanksgiving 11/24, and Christmas 12/14)
- Counseling Assembly with young adult speaker on the importance of student mental health will be presented during C Schedule and broadcast via livestream through First Block class Teams platform on 12/2
- Sports for schools prohibited by the directives of the City of Philadelphia from November 20<sup>th</sup> through January 1<sup>st</sup>
- Details and schedules to follow on other Student Life events such as Christmas-themed events including Christmas Sweater Day and virtual student socials
- All other appropriate Student Handbook policies still apply
