# "MORE COMMON" Symptoms Consistent with COVID-19

- ☐ Fever greater than or equal to 100.4°F
- □ NEW onset and/or worsening cough
- □ Difficulty breathing
- ☐ NEW loss of taste or smell
- If ONE symptom is checked, follow SECOND PATH

#### **FIRST PATH**

- Evaluate symptom and determine if the student is well enough to attend or remain in school or program.
- If not feeling well, student should stay home and consider an evaluation from a health care provider.
- Student may return to school 24 hours after symptom improved.
- ➡ Siblings and household contacts DO NOT need to stay home or quarantine.

#### **SECOND PATH**

- ➡ Student must stay home in isolation for at least 10 days from time symptoms started until symptoms improved AND no fever for 24 hours without medication. (Consider testing; reverse page)
- → Siblings and household contacts stay home and quarantine from all activities for at least 14 days.

### **CLOSE CONTACT PATH**

"Close contact" definition: a person who was within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes of someone tested positive for COVID-19

- Stay home from all activities for at least 14 days since last contact with positive case. Consider testing 5-7 days after last contact with positive case. Even if the student receives a negative test result, they need to complete the 14 days of quarantine before returning to school (cannot 'test out' of quarantine).
- Siblings and household contact DO NOT need to stay home or quarantine.
- ▶ **IF symptoms develop and/or positive test results received,** stay home in isolation for at least 10 days from time symptoms started until symptoms improved AND no fever for 24 hours without medication.
- Siblings and household contacts are now 'close contacts' and stay home and quarantine from all activities for at least 14 days.

## Medical Evaluation and/or COVID-19 Testing

# If you choose NOT to have a MEDICAL EVALUATION/TEST

#### **Second Path:**

ONE 'more common' or TWO 'less common' symptoms

- ➡ Student must stay home in isolation for at least 10 days from time symptoms started until symptoms improved AND no fever for 24 hours without medication.
- ➡ Siblings and household contacts stay home and quarantine from all activities for at least 14 days.

#### **ALTERNATIVE DIAGNOSIS**

Written documentation from the provider indicating alternative diagnosis or pre-existing condition is needed to return to school.

## **First or Second Path**

Student may return to school 24 hours after symptoms improved or as directed by health care provider

- Siblings and household contacts DO NOT need to stay home once the alternative diagnosis is known.
- ➡ <u>Regardless of alternative diagnosis</u>, IF the student is *also* tested for COVID-19, the student and household contacts must stay home until results are received.

#### **TESTED FOR COVID-19**

#### **First or Second Path**

▶ Student and household contacts must stay home until results are received:

#### **▶** NEGATIVE COVID-19 Test Results:

- Student may return to school 24 hours after symptoms improved or as directed by health care provider.
- Siblings and household contacts DO NOT need to stay home once the negative result is known.

#### **▶** POSITIVE COVID-19 Test Results:

- Student must stay home and continue to isolate for at least 10 days from time symptoms started until symptoms improved AND no fever for 24 hours without medication.
- Siblings and household contacts are now considered 'close contacts' and must continue to quarantine from all activities for at least 14 days.
- Quarantine timelines are based on the last day you were in close contact with the positive person.
