Wednesday, May 1: Cum Laude Society Induction Ceremony

The Assembly will take place in the SPSG Performance Gym at 9:30 a.m. Parents of inductees will receive notification.

Monday, May 6-Friday, May 17: Advanced Placement Exams

Friday, May 17: Senior Day

This is a day of celebration for the seniors. More information will be provided over the next few weeks in parent newsletters.

Saturday, May 18: Senior Prom

Seniors are currently planning their prom, and information will follow. Buses will pick up all seniors, juniors, and their dates at SPSG. Students must take the buses to the prom site and return on those same buses.

Monday, May 20-Friday, May 31: Senior Projects

Students know that they may begin these projects only if all academic work and community service hours are complete.

Monday, June 3 from 10:30-11:30 a.m.: Graduation Rehearsal & Class Day Practice

Prior to the Senior Project Luncheon there will be mandatory graduation rehearsal and Class Day practice. Students should bring their graduation shoes to practice walking and determine height and placement.

Monday, June 3 at 12:00 p.m.: Senior Project Luncheon

This is a mandatory lunch for students and SPSG faculty mentors to present their Senior Projects.

Wednesday, June 5: Class Day Ceremony & Moving Up Ceremony

This is a full day for Seniors from 8:30 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Class Day Ceremony begins at 11:00 a.m. Seniors are expected to wear dresses of appropriate length that cover their shoulders and without any cutouts. Please make sure that no under garments are visible. Moving Up Ceremony, which is a student only event, is from 1:00-3:00 p.m. There will be an hourlong Graduation rehearsal from 9:00-10:00 a.m. and 3:00-4:00 p.m.

Thursday, June 6 at 6:30 p.m.: Baccalaureate at Old St. Paul's Church

All seniors are required to attend. The girls need to be there at 6:00 p.m., dressed appropriately with no bareback, no exposed shoulders, and no gum. We recommend girls bring a small bag or only their keys and ask that parents hold onto them for the girls during the service. Because space is limited at OSP and both SP and SPSG take part in the ceremony, only immediate family members should plan on attending.

Friday, June 7 at 10:30 a.m.: Graduation

Seniors must arrive by 7:50 a.m. and go to the Student Commons. Class and other group photos will begin soon thereafter. The girls need to be dressed appropriately in their previously-approved, all-white, full-length dresses and white shoes. The dresses should not be low cut in the front and/or back, and should not have any ostentatious or differently-colored ornamentation or trim. Seniors should have appropriate, neutral-colored undergarments, including slips. They should not chew gum. If you have any questions, please contact Mrs. Hassan or Ms. Ure. Each senior will be given six reserved seats, 15 invitations to graduation, and 15 announcements. You may, of course, invite as many family members and friends as you wish to the ceremony; however, they will be seated in the section of non-reserved seats. The six reserved seats will be distributed by lottery. Invitations and announcements will arrive in early May, and seniors will receive them at a class meeting.
