The purpose of the study tour is to forge connections between classrooms in the UAE and USA and provide primary experiences for US educators to engage with the Middle East and bring that knowledge back to their classrooms. The trip will take place from March 8 through March 17, 2019.

Through the generous support of the UAE Embassy participants will be able to interact with top UAE government officials, visit internationally renowned museums, participate in cultural activities, visit schools and universities.

Each year, the Council partners with a third-party organization to fund country-specific programming that includes a teacher professional development workshop and a trip for up to a dozen teachers to that country. North Texas educators have traveled to Morocco, India, Jordan, Saudi Arabia and Turkey in recent years.
