ON CAMPUS

In-Person Instruction 5 Days a Week

- Health and safety protocols in place (increased hand washing stations, established circulation patterns, reduced density and distancing protocols in classrooms, required cloth face masks for adults and K-6 students)
- Full-day schedule
- Staggered drop-off and pick-up times
- Reduced class sizes with established cohorts
- A lead and an associate teacher for each cohort
- Block-scheduled Specialty classes
- Access to Village will be available
- Campus access will be limited to students, faculty, and staff

WALDEN@HOME

Virtual Instruction 5 Days a Week

- A full-time distance learning option will be available for students who choose or are not able to attend in-person on-campus instruction
- Blend of synchronous and asynchronous virtual learning
- Personalized assignments and support
- Ongoing parent support
- Built-in small group and one-on-one time with teacher
- Project-based learning in a multi-age setting
- Established start time
- Daily attendance taken
- Daily access to teacher
