This year, we are excited to announce that Harvest Moon has partnered with *HotLunch.com* to provide an easy way for parents to sign up for Hot Lunch on a yearly, weekly, or daily basis.

- To sign up and access your account, login at http://harvestmoon.ahotlunch.com/login using the school code: ws12.
- Once your account is setup, please add your children by inputting the necessary information including name and grade (please note: when asked for "Classroom/Division," please select "Default" from the drop-down menu; when asked for "Preferred Size," please leave as is with "Regular" marked as the default size).
- You can pre-order lunches by selecting specific dates throughout each month (pre-ordering is available until 9pm the night before). If you are interested in ordering a late drop in lunch, this option is available until 10am the day of.
 - o To view the menus and make purchases, select Order from the left navigation bar, click New Order, and make your selections.
- You can also order hot lunch for the entire school year by selecting Advance Payment from the left navigation bar and entering \$1134.00.
 - o To view the menus first, select Order from the left navigation bar, click New Order, and make your selections. You can just use this as a viewing tool if you decide to purchase for the year!
 - o Yearly hot lunch must be purchased by October 1.
- Once registered, you can use *HotLunch.com's* iOS app from using domain name: harvestmoon for easy ordering!
