

How to Use Zoom: An Introduction

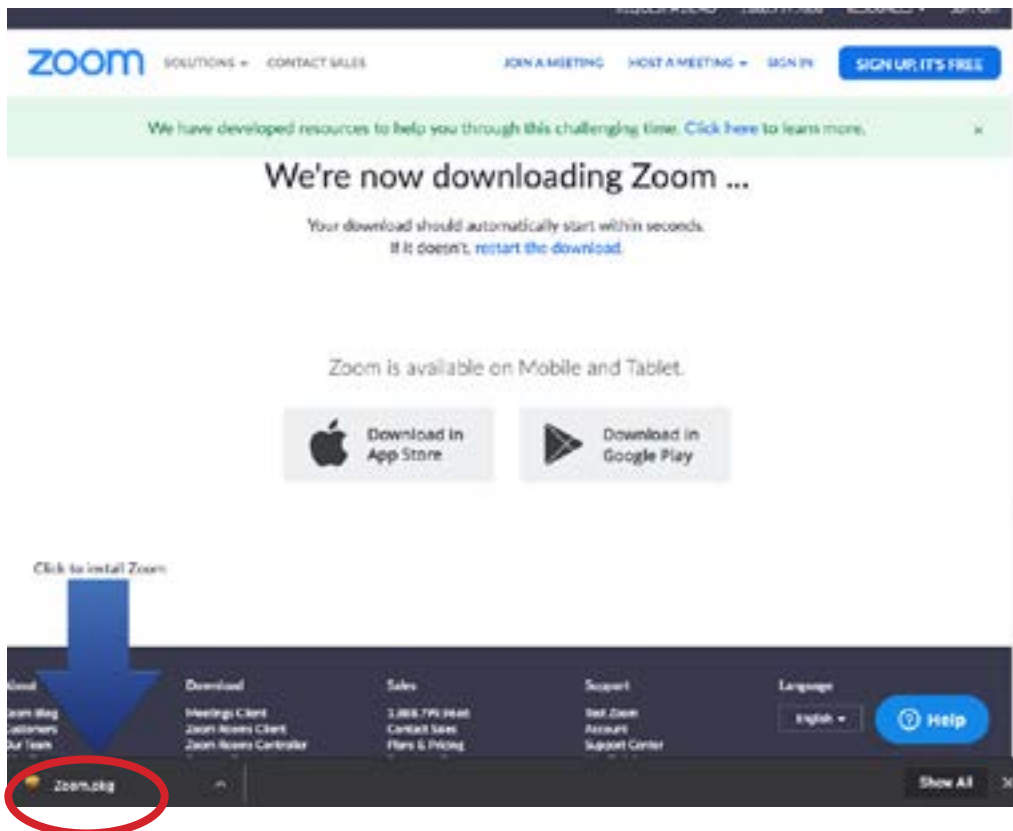
Getting Started

To use Zoom you will need:

- A video camera, either built in to your device or a separate webcam (most modern computers, smartphones and tablets have this built in) Please note: You can join a Zoom meeting without a camera, your image won't appear to others)
- A microphone, either built in to your device or in the webcam (most modern computers, smartphones and tablets have this built in), **OR a phone (a landline or a cellphone)**
- A broadband internet connection (this means an internet connection that is not dial-up. Your home WiFi and your cellphone services are broadband).
- The Zoom client (the software) installed on your machine. (Zoom has clients for Windows, Mac, iOS, and Android)

How to download zoom on your device computer (if you are downloading to a phone or tablet, please see the next page

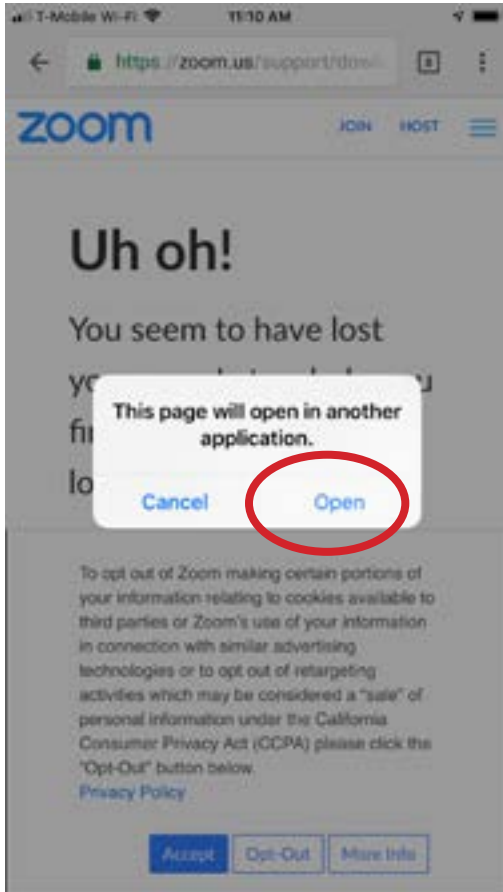
- Click on the link: <https://zoom.us/support/download>



- Click on the box underneath the large blue arrow on the bottom left
- Follow the prompts to download
- Once complete you can now join a meeting! (you do not need an account to join a Zoom meeting)
- Note: If you signed up without a microphone, check your invite for Dial-in information. Using that will allow you to listen and participate
- as well.

How to download Zoom to a phone or tablet

- Click on the link: <https://zoom.us/support/download> or visit the App Store on an iPhone or Google Play on a Android. The app is free.



Now you can join a Zoom meeting, simply by clicking the link sent by your host! You only need to download the client (software) once (all meetings now will open upon clicking the link provided by your host.
