

# Here are some of the many leadership, advocacy and influence opportunities undertaken this quarter and across 2023.

- The first Advisory Group meeting was held in June for the TMR Collaborative Procurement model rollout. TMR is holding its own group of internal meetings and champions are being selected to model culture on-site rollouts. Advisory meetings are continuing until the end of 2023.
- The Infrastructure Industry Steering Committee IISC hosted two workshops on Productivity, based on Governance and Commercial in mid-July on Productivity. These workshops included all IISC members and some additional invitees with expertise in these areas. The aim is to provide summarized findings to all in due course. IISC has hosted two Future Infrastructure: Private Investment workshops which discussed Connectivity, Decarbonisation and Circular economy as well as Games and Energy. IISC met last week to discuss productivity and project timelines. Finally, the DSD has hosted an invite-only in-confidence market sounding like smaller precincts for the Games during mid-July with a communique to be provided to the industry soon.
- IAQ continues to work alongside SCC and SCBC to revise the summit program and dissect it into meaningful overarching pillars for discussion at the post-summit round table to be held in September. My thanks to Terry Rossitto for his amazing work on this project.
- As part of ongoing Advocacy, IAQ CEO meets with Ministers, Director Generals, Deputy Director Generals, Executive Directors, QLD Tourism's Cameron Costello, and associated organisations including, EA, AI, CA, ACA, CCF, State Development, TMR, Treasury, Inland Rail, Health Minister, QMCA, Committee for Brisbane, Chamber of Commerce etc. Of note during the past two months, meetings with policy advisor for Minister Fentiman, Leah Lang, Leah Kelly, Sally Stannard, Jamie Merrick, DSD representatives for the Assembly, Bob Gee, Mark Cridland, Mayor Frank Beveridge, Melanie Syron, Warwick Agnew and Damon Hall. We meet regularly on like-minded issues.
- IAQ in the Regions – Cairns regional forum held in mid-July and Mackay planned for 6 October with guest speakers Paul Martyn and Kieran Cusack. Full calendar of regional proposed forums and reach for 2024 to be included in IAQ calendar 2024.
