






2022 Vital Congregations Re-BOOT Camp



Pastors and congregations are encouraged to come as teams of 3 – 5 people for a time of inspiration, learning, planning, sharing, experimenting, visioning, and implementing.

NOTE: This training is for people who did NOT attend the Vital Congregations Re-BOOT Camp in 2021.

- These principles will be explored throughout the course:
- Focusing on Jesus and justice
 - Being expectant of the Holy Spirit
 - Living as disciples of Jesus
 - Multiplying leaders who are young, diverse and bring fresh insights
 - Aligning with purpose and core values



These best practices will be explored throughout the course:

- **Growing relationship with God, one another and the community**
- **Staying connected with changing communities**
- **Engaging beyond cultural comfort zones**
- **Leading with intentionality**
- **Taking risks and experimenting**
- **Deepening faith practices**
- **Being imaginative and playful**
- **Leading healthy change**
- **Identifying “let go” opportunities**
- **Developing and/or expanding signature ministries**
- **Visioning, discerning, taking action and reflecting**
- **Celebrating everything (process, people, progress)**
- **Staying nimble and staying humble**

This will be a fast paced co-creative and co-experimental RE-BOOT CAMP facilitated by leaders with steep experience in redeveloping congregations as well as added guest presenters from a variety of settings with a wealth of knowledge.



We expect all participants to experience formation, hold a greater understanding of the broader mission, have clarity about their individual mission, find new allies from within the cohort, acquire knowledge on how to live that out in community, and gain confidence to share what they have learned with the world.



Participants are invited to bring their own ideas and experience to the table to create a lab of best practices, fresh ideas, and opportunities so they leave with clear plans for mission to young, new and diverse people.
