Beginner—Students will learn how to recognize the letters of the aleph bet, read basic words in the Siddur, and follow along in the service. Text: a virtual copy of *Shalom Aleichem*, by Noah Golinkin will be provided to each student

Advanced Beginner—Prerequisites: Students should have the skills detailed in the Beginner class description. In the Advanced Beginner class, students will learn to smoothly read words in central prayers such as Ashrei, Aleinu and the Shema. They will also study home-based prayers such as the Kiddush and Birkat HaMazon. Students should have a Siddur to use during the class

Intermediate—Prerequisites: Students should have the skills detailed in the Beginner and Advanced Beginner class description. In the Intermediate class, students will improve their reading fluency using the Haggadah and prayers in sections of the Shabbat service, including the Torah service, Mussaf, Hallel and the Amidah. Students should have a Siddur and a Haggadah to use during the class.
