

Congressman Rodney Davis (IL-11)

Congressman Rodney Davis is currently serving his fifth term in Congress representing the 13th District of Illinois, which covers a 14-county region including both urban and rural communities in central and southwestern Illinois. Congressman Davis serves on the Committee on House Administration, where he is the Ranking Member; the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, where he is the Ranking Member of the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit; and the House Committee on Agriculture.

During his time in Congress, Congressman Davis has worked with his colleagues on both sides of the aisle. In the previous session of Congress, the Lugar Center & Georgetown University's McCourt School of Public Policy's Bipartisan Index ranked Congressman Davis as the most bipartisan member of Congress from the state of Illinois and the 14th most bipartisan nationwide. Congressman Davis is a member of the Congressional Building Trades Caucus led by Congressman Donald Norcross (D-NJ-1) and Congressman David McKinley (R-WV-1).

Congressman Davis has been a strong supporter of Davis-Bacon/Prevailing wage protection on infrastructure projects and expanding registered apprenticeship programs. Congressman Davis also was a strong leader in the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, which provided great relief to NECA contractors and helped expand their market share.
