This past week, NECA members sent safety professionals from across the country to the first ever NECA Safety Professionals Institute (NSPI) in Washington, DC. The three day, in-person session was conducted at NECA headquarters and covered essential safety management concepts. Participants, coming from various backgrounds and experience levels represented safety leaders ranging from entry to executive level employees. The NECA Safety Professionals Institute (NSPI) includes inside and outside oriented topics, online pre-work, an in-person workshop, and a capstone project that takes advantage of all that was learned and adds value to their respective company safety programs. Outside Line oriented topics include - Isolate/Insulate, Grounding/Bonding, Designated Observer, Helicopter Safety Awareness, and Aerial Lift/Digger Derrick Safety. The course will close with recognition of participants at the NECA Safety Professionals Conference (NSPC) in Denver, CO in May of 2024. During the conference, participants will share their experience with the course and showcase their capstone projects during a group presentation. This course will be conducted annually with an emphasis on preparing the next generation of safety professionals for a successful career of protecting lives in our industry.
