



NECA Names Kyle Krueger as Director, Codes and Standards

The National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA) announced it has named Kyle Krueger as Director, Codes and Standards.

Krueger started in the electrical construction industry in 1997, working up to becoming a journeyman wireman and obtaining his Master Electrician License in 2004. In 2010 he taught evening code classes for the Milwaukee JATC's continuing education program, recognizing the potential of improving the industry through education and contractor support. In 2013 Krueger began serving as the Milwaukee Electrical JATC's Continuing Education Coordinator and the Milwaukee Chapter, NECA's Code Consultant and Safety Director.

Serving on the NECA National Codes and Standards Committee since 2016, Krueger has represented NECA as a principal member of Code Making Panel 3 for the National Electrical Code and Correlating Committee for NFPA 72. He has been an active member of the Wisconsin Chapter of the International Association of Electrical Inspectors (IAEI), serving on the Board of Directors for seven years and representing the organization as President.

To support the association, Krueger will manage and maintain the development and process, publishing, and cyclical revision of NECA's ANSI-accredited National Electrical Installation Standards (NEIS) program. He will coordinate with subject matter experts and other electrical construction experts to develop industry-wide standards. On top of additional responsibilities, Krueger will help ensure NECA contractors operate efficiently with up-to-date standards developments.
