Rep. Dan Newhouse was first elected to Congress in 2014. During his tenure he has been an advocate for strengthening and supporting our registered apprenticeship programs as well as further expanding our workforce. Rep. Newhouse currently serves on the Appropriations committee, focusing his work on the Agriculture, Legislative Branch, Energy and Water subcommittees, he also serves as the Chair of the Congressional Western Caucus and is an active member of the Bipartisan Working Group and the Republican Main Street Partnership.

Before being elected to Congress, Rep. Newhouse served four terms in the Washington State House of Representatives from 2003 to 2009 before taking the role as the state director of the Department of Agriculture. He is a lifelong resident of Central Washington and third-generation Yakima Valley farmer and is the former president of the Hops Growers of America and Washington State Farm Bureau.
