'The 2017 Barolo Monvigliero draws its fruit from the village of Verduno where this historic winery makes its home. It shows delicate aromas of wild berry and rose, and there is an underlying mineral note that appears with delicate intensity in this vintage.' Wine Advocate

Testamatta, Toscana, Bibi Graetz 2019 £438 per 6bt c/s ML 94

'A pure expression of Sangiovese, the Bibi Graetz 2019 Testamatta is a wine in constant evolution. Bibi has added 17 more hectares of vineyard to the program, with 12 hectares in Fiesole (north of Florence) and 5 hectares in San Donato in colle (south of Florence) with 70-year-old-vines. The base of the wine sees fruit from old vines planted in the 1950s in the cool-climate Lamole subzone of chianti Classico. These new terroirs bring a lot more aromatic nuance and complexity to the wine with perfumed blue flower, candied orange peel, wet earth and plummy black fruit. White Alberese soil add a strong chalky mineral signature to the finish of this elegantly streamlined and linear Tuscan red' Wine Advocate
