#### **Progressive Pathways Fair**

County Tipperary's first Progressive Pathways Fair took place under Tipperary CYPSC auspices in the Anner Hotel, Thurles on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The purpose of the fair was to showcase **further training**, **Higher Education and employment opportunities** for young adults with additional support needs who are moving on from Post Primary level.

A range of agencies met and worked together to organise this event, including North Tipperary Development Company, South Tipperary Development Company, Tipperary Education and Training Board, the Department of Social Protection, the EmployAbility services in the North and South of the county, Knockanrawley Resource Centre, Youth Work Ireland Tipperary, St. Cronan's Centre Roscrea, Local Link and the HSE.

The fair was well attended by professionals, parents and young people who came to browse and ask for information from some 18 agencies who had set out their stalls for the event. Fergus Finlay, currently Chairperson of the Implementation Group for the Employment Strategy for Disabilities, was the keynote speaker. There were also presentations from two young adults about their work experience and from four employers who had offered work placements.



12 Days of Christmas- a Fire Safety Message from South Tipperary Fire & Rescue Service



On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Christmas - Make sure you test your smoke alarm

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Christmas - Check your Christmas tree lights, make sure they conform to a British Standard. In addition check you have the correct fuse. Always switch them off and unplug them when you go to bed or leave the house.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Christmas - Never leave candles burning whilst unattended

On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Make sure you, your family and any guests that may be staying are aware of what they need to do in the event of a fire. Make a fire escape plan.

On the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Never overload electrical sockets

On the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Never leave cooking unattended

On the 7<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas – Decorations can burn easily- don't attach them to lights or heaters

On the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Make sure that candles and cigarettes are properly extinguished before you go to bed.

On the 9<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Never place candles or any other naked flame near a Christmas tree. As your tree begins to dry out it becomes highly flammable.

On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Keep matches and lighters well away from children.

On the 11<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas – Take time to check on elderly relatives and friends this Christmas-make sure they are Fire Safe.

On the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas - Celebrate Christmas and New Year safely. The risk of accidents, especially in the kitchen, is greater after alcohol if consumed.
