What is Work Inspiration?



Work Inspiration Reach Out is a multi employer program that supports young Australians to find out more about themselves, build their aspirations and engage with employers first-hand.

WHAT'S INVOLVED

- •Employers host a group of 15-20 students in either year 9, 10 or 11
- •A typical visit lasts for 2 hours and combines a variety of activities such as a tour of the facilities, 'Speed Careering' session where students interview 3-6 staff members to learn about their personal career journey, a fun activity related to the industry they're visiting and information on career pathways and opportunities
- •A morning tea or lunch break is scheduled as part of the visit and is a valuable opportunity for staff to mingle with the students and continue with careers related conversations



Work Inspiration Student Engagement



Q. How many programs are run each year?

A. Multiple Work Inspiration programs occur in every Australian state and territory each year.

Q. Who attends these programs?

A. The Smith Family operates in communities with high levels of disadvantage, meaning many of the students who participate, come from a background with limited support or opportunities.

Q. How are the students selected?

A. The Smith Family works with the school to select the most suitable students for each program, always prioritizing our scholarship students. We can also advise a school if a particular program has a focus such as careers for young women or Indigenous students, however we always follow the guidance provided by the school.



Why get involved in the Work Inspiration program?

- * Work Inspiration provides students with the opportunity to leave the familiar environment of the school grounds and step into the 'world of work' in a safe and supported manner.
- * Venturing into the workplace allows students to engage with employers, which builds confidence and creates connections.



- * Companies who engage in the Work Inspiration program find it to be a rewarding way to support the career education journey of young people.
- * Employees tell us that they appreciate the opportunity to share their story with local young people and inspire the next generation.
- * Work Inspiration is a chance for employers to share information on career opportunities within their company.
