“COVID-19 and accounting education: The state of play and what lies ahead”

Report on Event

It is pleasing to present this brief report on the above session, which has attracted much interest and ongoing attention.

In all, there were six Panel members, comprising Nicola Beatson, Garry Carnegie, Victoria Clout, Corinne Cortese, Brendan O’Connell and Meredith Tharapos. The Panel was chaired by AFAANZ Board Member, David Bond.

In all, 97 individuals registered to participate at the session. Of these, 71 were in Australia, 13 in New Zealand, and 13 from other countries/regions, consisting of two each from Indonesia, Italy, Portugal, and the UK, and one from each of Fiji, France, Germany, Japan and the USA.

The Panel presentation video was placed Online virtually immediately. To the time of writing, there have been 128 views of the recording. Of these views, 36 occurred in Australia, 21 in New Zealand leaving a total of 71 from other countries/regions.

Countries and viewers making up the “Rest of the World” detailed as follows: Portugal (21), Italy (9), UK (8), Spain (6), Japan (5), Singapore (4), Malaysia (3), Turkey (3), the USA (2) and one each from the following countries – Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Denmark, Egypt, Ireland, Lebanon, Mexico, Poland and Uruguay.

The evidence of the visits to the web site of the recording following the event indicates that this is a topic of much interest and relevance, including beyond the shores of Australia and New Zealand.
