HOW TO GET HERE...

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICES

Southampton Football Club run a dedicated Shuttle Bus Service from two different locations for all home and away supporters – Southampton Central Train Station and Town Quay. The service starts 2 hours before kick-off for all first team matches and runs every 10–15 minutes, depending on traffic. Contactless payments are accepted.

Please be aware that the shuttle bus from Southampton Central Station picks up from the South Side of the train station (Platform 4 side / Western Esplanade) and both shuttle buses drop fans at Britannia Road, just outside the stadium. ADDITIONAL BUS SERVICES

To get to St Mary's Stadium, hop on the <u>Bluestar 3</u>, <u>Bluestar 16</u>, or <u>Bluestar 18</u> which stops on Britannia Road, a short walk from the stadium. You can also catch the <u>Bluestar 7</u>, stopping at City College, which is also a short walk from the stadium.

Southampton City Council has set up a tool to help you plan your travel too, called My Journey Planner.

TRAIN

Southampton is served by Southampton Central Railway Station, which is approximately a mile from the stadium – roughly a 20-minute walk.

The train station has staff available 24/7 and there are help points on every platform. There is a cash machine at the train station, as well as refreshment facilities, toilets, pay phones and shops. The station is fully accessible to wheelchair users 24 hours a day.








MOTORCYCLES & CYCLING

Cycling is a quick and reliable way to get around Southampton on matchdays. The football club has free parking facilities at the stadium.

If you're coming on a bike or motorbike, please note that our bike racks and motorbike bays can be found at the front of the North Car Park, closest to Britannia Road.

If you're traveling by bike or motorbike you should enter and dismount at the stadium's North Car Park and liaise with security on entry. Road closures will be in place from 90 minutes before kick-off so entry will be denied for motorbikes only after this time. Cyclists will be permitted entry after this time but should prioritise pedestrians. The closures will remain in place until about 20-minutes after the final whistle.



TICKETING

UPON ARRIVAL

The away turnstiles and ticket office are located on the South Side of the stadium between the Chapel and Kingsland stands. Visiting supporters can use turnstile E to access the away stand and the ticket office is located next to the South Tunnel.

When attending the match fans are advised to enter the stadium via Melbourne Street, leaving the stadium will be via Melbourne Street only.



TICKETING

COLLECTIONS

Duplicate ticket requests will only be fulfilled if the information is sent to us, via email, from the visiting club's ticket office. If a supporter misplaces their ticket, they must contact their own club who will authorise and inform Southampton's Football Club's ticket office.

Duplicate tickets will not be issued without authorisation from a representative of the visiting club.

Duplicate Tickets will be available to pick up at the away ticket office, which is located next to the South Tunnel, up to three hours before kick-off and 15 minutes into the match.

TOUTING INFORMATION

Match tickets obtained via unauthorised sources (other than via the club) are not valid. If you pay more than the face value of a match ticket or have bought a match ticket(s) from a tout or an online ticket agency such ticket will be invalid and you are likely to be refused entry or ejected from the stadium.

The unauthorised sale of football tickets is a criminal offence under UK law.

Southampton Football Club and/or any registered ticket agent will only sell match tickets for Southampton Football Club matches at face value plus any administration charge.

GROUND REGULATIONS

SFC REPORT

At Southampton, we have a zero tolerance approach to any form of discrimination, bullying, victimisation or harassment.

It is vitally important to the Club that everyone feels welcome at St Mary's Stadium. This means that we will take the strongest possible action to eliminate any form of discrimination from our stadium.

If you are the victim or a witness to such behaviour we ask that you text 'SFCReport' to 60060 with a description and location of the incident, at the time of the incident. Please provide as much detail as possible.

If you wish to expand on the details you have provided about the offence, please email supporterservices@saintsfc.co.uk

This may include specific seat details if applicable, descriptions of persons involved, and exact words and phrases wherever possible. We recommend that you save the number to your phone and text discreetly to help us challenge bad behaviour at St Mary's. Supporters are also encouraged to report any behaviour that they are not comfortable with to any of our stewards or other staff. All reported concerns will be investigated appropriately and confidentially.

EVACUATION PROCESS

In the event of an emergency, please carefully follow the instructions that are announced over the tannoy system and the directions of our stewarding team.

BANNERS/FLAGS

There is only a limited amount of space to display banners/ flags within the stadium. Banners/flags above 2 metre square will not be accepted unless they have a fire certificate to say they are safe. Banners above 3 metres square have to be pre-arranged with the Safety Officer and may be refused. They must not obstruct the view of others, cover advertising signs or cause a safety hazard. Banners/ flags must not display any abusive or threatening words, images or political statements.

BAG POLICY

Bags should be no bigger than A4 size and will be subject to a search prior to entry. They must be small enough to fit under your seat, without causing any obstructions to the walkways.
