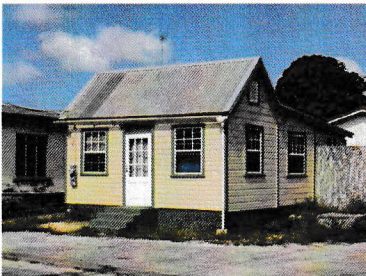
EABC was founded in the 1930s during the construction of Hoover Dam.



- **Food security means:**
 - Adequate income to buy food
 - Access to quantity and quality of *nutritious* food
- **Insecurity comes from:**
 - Rent increases
 - Medical/prescription bills
 - Unexpected costs: car repair, etc



- **Food donations from Albertsons Boulder City Store in pounds:**
 - July 1, 2022-June 30, 2023: 108,000
 - July 1, 2022--Oct 16, 2022: 32,000
 - July 1, 2023--Oct 16, 2023: 30,600
- EABC also receives dozens of donations from many in the community
- Pantry hours: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 8:45am-11:15am



- **Housing security is a safe place each day/night:**
 - Better health
 - Better attendance/results at school/work
 - Nevada rents: 19% higher than 2022, Per LV Review Journal
- **EABC Housing support for rent and utility payments:**
 - July 1, 2022-June 30, 2023: 266 residents
 - July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022: 227 residents
