### Yukon

- Gyms, fitness facilities spas, and entertainment venues within city limits are prohibited from operating or opening to patrons.
- Bars and similar venues, hair salons, barber shops with city limits may remain open using every other chair table or station.
- Dine-in services for food products are limited to every other table in the establishment with only up to six (6) seated at each table and with CLOSED FOR SERVICE signs clearly indicating which tables are so designated placed on each table not being used for dine-in service.
