



PROCLAMATION 07-01-2020 (A)

WHEREAS, Oklahoma County has recently seen an increase in COVID-19 cases;

WHEREAS, health professionals and researchers have determined the activities and the types of businesses contributing to this surge in community spread of the virus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City has promulgated new rules for regulating specific businesses and activities that the data shows to be contributing significantly to the spread of the virus; and

WHEREAS, the current status of the pandemic warrants that the City of The Village adopt Emergency Measures and guidelines to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public pursuant to the provisions and emergency powers granted by Chapter 8 of The Village City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY CITY CHARTER, CITY ORDINANCE AND STATE LAW THE MAYOR OF THE OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE, OKLAHOMA PROCLAIMS AS FOLLOWS:

The Emergency Measures promulgated by the City of Oklahoma City on July 3, 2020 shall become effective at the same time in the corporate limits of the City of The Village and shall only apply to those activities and businesses The Village has in common with Oklahoma City. Said Emergency Measures shall remain in effect until further notice.
