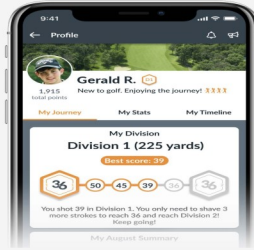

## Pace of Play Tips!

One of the most important factors to maintaining a good pace of play is that groups are punctual to their starting times and maintain pace with the group in front of them. Groups who are not ready to play at their scheduled time cause gaps on the course that ultimately slow play behind them.

If you are looking to play and do not have a starting time, make sure to check in with the golf shop so they can get you out on the course in a spot that does not disrupt pace. During busy periods when a brisker pace is not available it is often better to pair up smaller groups into fours. Cutting onto the golf course without checking in can cause delays with groups enjoying their round and disrupts our ability keep the tee times moving on schedule. Starting times can be made online through your member account login or by calling the golf shop.

## PLEASE REPAIR BALL MARKS! Only YOU can prevent ball mark damage!

### RIGHT!

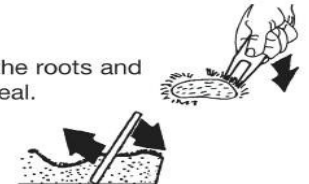
- 1) Close the gap/hole with putter by patting down the ball mark.
- 2) Insert *Green-Save* tool on the high side behind ball mark and push the back toward the center.
- 3) Do not pull up, twist or lift with the tool.
- 4) Push both sides of the ball mark into the center.
- 5) Gently tap the surface down with putter.
- 6) Never use loosened turf for repair.



### WRONG!

Pulling up or lifting on the center or the sides will tear the roots and result in brown spots taking weeks for the surface to heal.

Do not pull up or twist with tool. This will only bring sand to the surface and tear the root system



### RIGHT!

Insert tool and push back and sides forward to center. No damage to root system. Healing starts immediately.

## Removing the Old Pumps

Before the old pumps could be removed, the roof had to be taken off the pump house. This involved removing all the beams, insulation and metal roofing.

Once everything was out of the way, we were able to take out the old pumps and electrical systems using a crane.

**Subs**- If a player is going to miss a week they may find a substitute. Finding a substitute is the responsibility of the player. **NON- MEMBERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR LEAGUE PLAY.**

**Cost**-\$70 per player

**Points Totals**- League is split into 2 halves (6 weeks each). Each week teams will have a match with another team, 3 different formats of match play will be in use (individual, best ball, scramble) 4 points will be in play each week. There will be a payout for top point totals each half. There will also be 2 bonus weeks to end the year with a qualifying round one week and a derby for the finale.

**Year end Derby**- The top 2 teams from each flight for the halves will automatically qualify for the derby on August 16th. Ties will be broken by high weekly point totals from week 6 working backwards. There will be 2 more spots from each flight available at the qualifier league night on August 9th. Format for the qualifier is 1-net best ball.

Each week there will be a \$5 per player skins/CTP game. Skins games will be flighted. There will also be a Death pool (\$20 per team each half) with cash prizes awarded at the end of the half for the last team or teams standing.

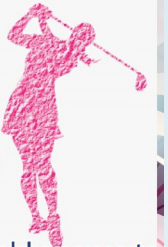
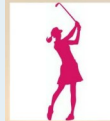

Removing the Old Pumps



Removing the Old Pumps

For the new pumps to go all the way to the bottom, and run as efficiently as possible, all the dirt needed to be removed from the pit.



Putting in the New Pumps

The new system, weighing in at 7,500 pounds arrived early Tuesday, March 22.



## Putting in the New Pumps

Since the new pump system and platform weighed so much, a bigger crane had to be called in. This crane weighed around 90,000 pounds!



## Repairs

With all the lumber in place, we put all the metal roofing back on and with a few more adjustments, the pump house will be fully repaired.

The first picture shows the tie in from the old system to the new pumps. The second picture shows the filter clean out pipe.



## Rebuilding

Due to animals nesting, water damage and other issues, most of the cross-beams in the roof, as well as all of the insulation was thrown out. That meant that new boards needed to be purchased to insure structural stability.



## Finishing Touches

With the electrical systems installed, the pump system will be able to communicate with the satellites, computer and an app that can be downloaded to a phone or tablet.
