Interested in enrolling in a French study program that is offered only in Quebec? Good news! You might be eligible for the tuition fee exemption granted to Canadian students wishing to pursue their studies at UdeM.

Benefit from reduced tuition fees to study in Montreal

Since Fall 2023, Canadian students from outside Quebec have the chance to pay the same tuition fees as Quebec residents when enrolling in certain French-language university programs in Quebec. This initiative supports talented students in their academic pursuits by making education more accessible and affordable.

How to obtain the tuition fee exemption for Fall 2025

- Make sure you qualify!
- To benefit from this tuition fee exemption, you must:
- · Hold Canadian citizenship without being a Quebec resident
- · Reside in Canada
- 2. Find a study program that matches your aspirations! To qualify for the tuition fee exemption, programs must be in French

and not offered in any other Canadian province. Luckily, many of the programs offered at UdeM fit the bill!

3. Submit your application to study at UdeM within the specified deadline.

Once you've accepted your offer, you'll simply need to upload proof of your Canadian residency in the online Student Centre, and the tuition fee exemption will be all yours!
